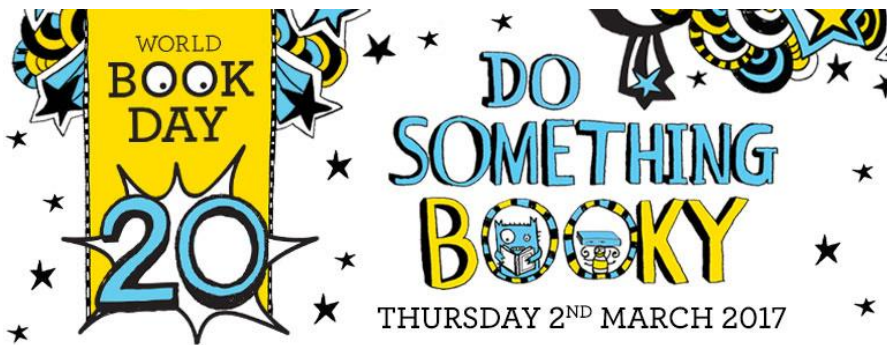


*This term our theme is Hope.*
