Literacy	<p>Fiction - I can explore tales from another country, write journey and 'monster' tales. Non-Fiction - I can write letters and a report on a chosen animal. Maths	<p>I can recognise place value. I can use simple addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. I can name and describe the properties of 3D shapes. I can tell the time to the nearest quarter on digital and analogue clocks. I can create and interpret different graphs. I can find totals of money using pounds and pence.</p>
Science	<p>I can identify and name a variety of common animals. I understand the terms carnivore, herbivore, omnivore. I know that animals have offspring and can say what they need to stay alive. I can recognise and describe habitats, naming plants and animals which live within these. I can use and create simple food chains.</p>
Computing	<p>I know all about E-Safety I can use a range of multimedia packages to present information. I can use Paint programs to create pictures. I can use the internet to find information about animals.</p>
History & Geography	<p>I can name the 7 continents. I can find out about life in another country by comparing it to where we live. I can recognise human and physical features of a locality.</p>
