Reception Reminders for September 2020

Dear parent / carer,

We hope you have had been able to have some sort of 'normal' this Summer and enjoyed time with your families, who are hopefully all still safe and well?

This letter is to remind you of the organisational elements in place for starting school on Monday 7th September. It also includes a few updates on our safety measures.

Wearing of masks

We strongly recommend that all pupils above nursery and reception age, and parents wear a mask when entering and leaving the school. The expectations are also being made of staff, and we have provided two washable masks and a number of disposable masks for each member of staff. Staff and pupils will also be instructed how to correctly remove and dispose of masks.

Travel to school

We encourage all families to come to school in one-household groups and, if at all possible, so walk or cycle to school.

Parents are respectfully asked to be prompt on entry and exit and are asked to not come onto the school site and to socially distance whilst waiting outside the premises. Look out for the duckling footprints to the left of the gate to help you!

If you wish to contact a member of staff, please do so by email or by ringing the school.

At collection time children will be led to the gates by a member of school staff in a socially distanced line to ensure safe collection by adults.

Uniform reminder

Children should wear the normal school uniform, it only needs to be washed as regularly as you usually would according to the washing instructions. Children should bring their PE kits to leave in school all week for the first 2 weeks. We are encouraging all children to wear trainers to school as we want to use the outside allocated areas as much as possible.

Recovery Curriculum

As mentioned in a previous communication, we will be focusing on missed learning and reinforcing skills previously learned. Alongside this, during this first term, a holistic approach to ensuring children are safe and settled will be used. Your children will be coming home talking about reconnecting, celebrating our strengths and feeling safe. As part of this, you will receive a questionnaire to answer about how your child has responded to lockdown and this will support our future planning for your child. I am really happy to communicate more about this curriculum should parents wish to have this information.
